Attachments Table Macro

Prompt

Displays a table of attachments to the current, or a specified, page.

Definition

This macro is a richer alternative to Confluence's built-in Attachments List macro. With it you can show all the attachments on a specified page arranged in a table format where [Filter Groups](#) comprise the columns and an attachment's [Filters](#) show in the respective cells.
